September Outing – OA Fall Fellowship

What: Order of the Arrow Fall Fellowship

Where: TFC Adventure Camp, Rochelle, IL.

When: Friday, September 11, 2009 through Sunday, September 13th.

Who: This outing is limited to Scouts and adult leaders who are members of the Order of the Arrow (OA). This outing is for those new Scouts, recently elected by their peers into the OA. These Scouts will have already done the Call-out Ceremony.

Transportation: Driving to / from the outing via pre-arranged carpooling. Please contact Mr. Fitzsimmons to volunteer as a driver. The TFC Adventure Camp (formerly the TFC Ranch) is about 1 hour drive from Naperville.

Lodging: This is an outdoor, overnight event. Ordeal Candidates will be sleeping in the open on Friday night so please bring a tarp to wrap around your sleeping bag so it does not get wet with dew in the morning. You will be sleeping in a Troop provided tent Saturday night. Others who are attending but not going through the Ordeal will use troop-provided tents for both nights.

Food: All food will be provided; you will not be required to bring any food or cook. The Ordeal Candidates will be fed a minimal breakfast and lunch on Saturday, followed by a full size dinner. Please make sure you eat a full meal on Friday night, prior to leaving for the outing.

Attire: BSA Class A attire is required during transportation to/from the outing. The Scouts will be outdoors throughout the outing, so dress accordingly. The Ordeal Candidates will be doing manual labor on Saturday, so bring work gloves and sturdy boots.

Equipment: Be prepared for outdoor camping.

 - i. Ordeal Candidates - \$50 now, \$55 if less than 2 weeks prior to the event
 - b. Fill out page 2 of this form and return it to Mr. Fitzsimmons.
 - c. Adults – clear your calendar so you can volunteer to join us!
2. **On September 11th**
 - a. Pack your gear. Please refer to your OA letter with further details on what to bring.
 - b. Also bring a copy of your Class 1 medical form or the new Annual BSA Health and Medical record, Part A. (keep in the back of your scout book), pack all medications you are using in a zip-loc bag with your name and a note with instructions.
 - c. Adults - Drop off your scout at St. Elizabeth Seton Church, east parking lot at **5:00 pm**

 - a. Adults – Your scout will be dropped off at your home sometime between 10am and noon. **Please arrange to have an adult at home during this drop off time.**
